Freshman Interdisciplinary Team (FIT) Program establishes the building blocks of critical thinking, study skills, effective writing and communication with their fellow classmates.

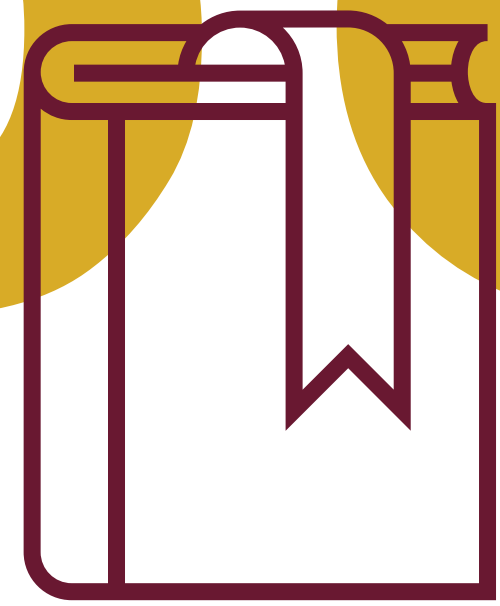
## STUDENT BODY

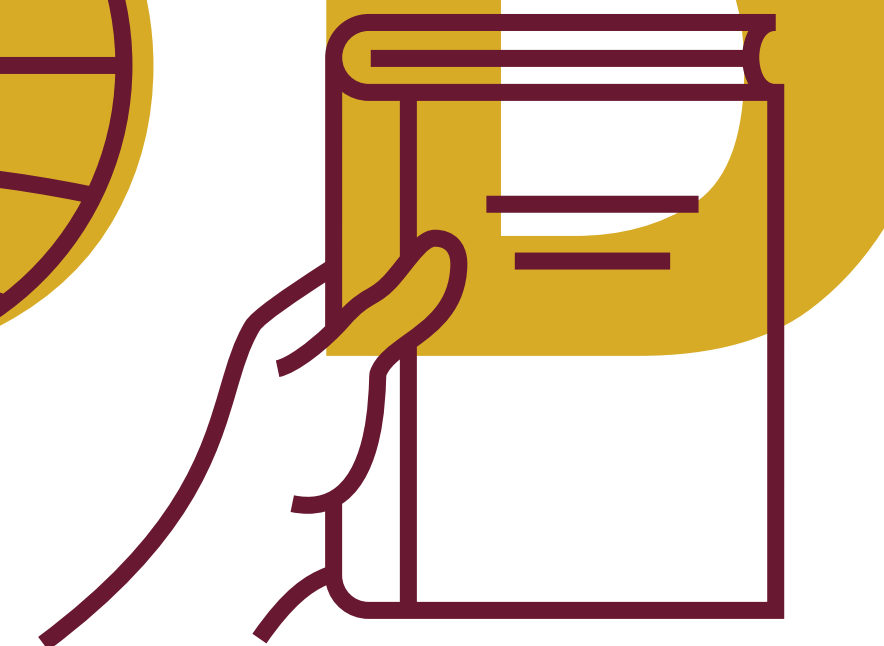
