### **Important Information:**

- Before testing, visit [cb.org/apexamterms](https://collegeboard.org/apexamterms) to read the 2022 AP Exam Terms and Conditions. You will need to agree to these Terms and Conditions before taking an AP Exam by signing a certification statement.
- All exams will take place at Timberline Church. Enter through the South Auditorium entrance.
- **Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to exam time;** late arrivals will not be admitted into the testing room.
- Students may bring a snack to eat during the break. Food and drinks are not permitted in the testing room, but may be kept in the break room.
- Remember to bring:
  - A photo ID (school or government-issued ID)
  - Two No. 2 pencils
  - Two pens, with black or dark blue ink
  - Up to two calculators (with fresh batteries):
    - Biology, Calculus AB/BC, Chemistry, Physics 2, and Statistics. Please see the Calculator Policy regarding what kind of calculator is best for each of these exams.
    - Calculators are not allowed for any other LCHS AP exams.

- NO CELL PHONES, no smart watches, or any other electronic equipment. Cell phones should be left at home or in your car.
- For morning exams, you will be excused from periods 1 – 5 for testing and lunch.
- For afternoon exams, you will be excused from periods 5 – 8. You must sign out in the front office when leaving campus.
