Kindergarten registration will begin on February 22nd for the 2023-2024 school year. Children reaching the age of **five**, on or before **October 1, 2023**, are eligible to register for kindergarten. Danielle Rooney, R.N. our school nurse will accept and review all medical registration materials **Wednesday, February 22nd through Friday, February 24th** between the hours of **9:00 - 11:00 a.m.** It is not necessary for your child to accompany you when you are completing the registration process with Miss Rooney.

To begin the process of registering your child for kindergarten, please complete the online portion of the registration at www.ncboe.org. In addition to the registration forms, you will need the following items. Parents are advised to compile all necessary information, including the completion of forms, before bringing them to Miss. Rooney.


Please bring the following items to Miss. Rooney during registration:

- 1. Child's original birth certificate or passport**
- 2. Completed and NOTARIZED certificate of residency**
(bring 4 additional documents showing proof of residency)
- 3. Completed registration form online at www.ncboe.org**
- 4. Completed immunization record *form can be accessed online at www.ncboe.org**
(Individual dates of all immunization must be recorded by your physician)
- 5. Completed medical report *form can be accessed online at www.ncboe.org**
(to be completed by your physician)
- 6. Completed dental report *form can be accessed online at www.ncboe.org**
(to be completed by your dentist)

All incoming kindergarten students and their parents are invited to **kindergarten orientation (date to be determined) through the email provided in the registration.**
