PROGRAM OVERVIEW

JUMP START is like summer school but in a short 3-day format. The goal is enrichment and getting students used to being on our campus to overcome the uncertainty that is common the first day of middle school. Students will attend just **ONE** of these three days.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

JUMP START will help students to feel comfortable on campus. The program includes a Campus Tour, 4 classes, and an Orientation Rally.

Students will be randomly assigned four 40-45-minute classes per day. The students will have a variation of enriching STEM, Socio-Emotional, Physical Education, and VAPA (Visual and Performing Arts).

All class supplies will be provided but it is recommended that the students bring a backpack.

Schedule changes won't be granted at this point as all the schedules have been printed and all the requests have been addressed.

NUTRITION AND TRANSPORTATION

We will provide your student with an optional **free lunch** during the 10:55 - 11:20 break in the School Cafeteria (MP room). We encourage students to bring a water bottle and some healthy snacks.

Parents are responsible for student's drop-off and pick-up, as Toby Johnson does not provide bus services.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

The **JUMP START** program is a continuum of the regular school year. The same Code of Conduct applies to the program as the regular school year. Our four encompassing program rules are **BE SAFE, BE RESPECTFUL, BE RESPONSIBLE** and **BE KIND**. We will work closely with students and families to promote success in the upcoming school year.

Cellphones or any electronic device won't be allowed to be used on campus at any time. Students will be instructed to **turn off their phones and remove earbuds** at their entrance on campus. DRESS CODE

Students must come dressed for physical activity. No flip flops or open toed shoes.

LOGISTICS

- Students will enter campus through the **Library Gate** (Refer to map #1)
- Students will pick up their schedules at arrival between 8:00-8:30 at a table set by the Library Gate Entrance.
- A teacher will meet the **first period group** of students and take them to a campus tour.
- Teachers will be holding a hand-held sign with their names so students can locate them.
- Students that arrive late (after 8:30 bell) will need to enter through the **Student Services** office. (Refer to map)
- Students will be dismissed at 12:30 and they will exit through the **Library Gate #1** and **Robert's Pass Gate #2**.

Arrival during **Jump Start**= 1 Library Gate

Dismissal during **Jump Start**=Library Gate #1 and Robert's Pass Gate #2.

Arrival during **regular school year** =Admin Gate next to student Services and Robert's Pass Gate.

Dismissal during **regular school year** =Library Gate #1 and Robert's Pass Gate #2.
