RPPS related items

- Parent talk Save the date (27 Jan). RPPS will hosting a virtual talk for parents on strategies to support your child with anxiety. Our school social worker, Joshua Hulley-Carroll, focuses on anxiety in his work with children. In his talk, he will be working through strategies parents can use with their children to help them navigate their emotions and their days. Watch for more information about the talk in January.
- School photos. We have a tentative date of 4 March for RPPS school photos.
 Students will be able to take for individual photos only; class photos and group photos are not permitted at this time.

Covid related items

- Rapid Antigen Testing Kits for Students. We have received the rapid testing kits, and our student helpers are organizing them into homeroom groupings for distribution. This Thursday (16 Dec), each student will receive a box which includes 5 rapid testing kits for student use over the school holidays. The use of these kits will be voluntary. If you do not wish to receive these kits, please let your child's teacher know.
- Daily Self-assessment Confirmation for students. When we return in January, you will be required to confirm that your child's daily assessment has been completed before school each day. We will be using the same electronic reporting system as we did in September. Here is the link to the form for your reference in January. Please note, there may be differences between the OPH and the provincial screening tools
- International Travel Keep RPPS safe and healthy. Families planning for international travel during the holidays should check current <u>federal protocols</u> that exist for travelers. International travel rules do change. For daily assessment, OPH strongly recommends using the OPH tool as this reflects the current Federal direction. Individuals must follow the direction of the Federal Government, as their advice overrules the advice in the screening tool.
- Vaccinations for children. Our public health nurse has shared COVID-19 Vaccine Info Sheet for Kids 5-11 <u>English version</u> or <u>French version</u>. You may also visit the <u>OPH</u> <u>website for schedules and information</u> about booking your child's vaccine; OPH will be using RPPS for a vaccination clinic on 20 December.
