Re: Parents/Guardians: Health Reminders

November 3, 2020

Dear Parents/Guardians/Students:

This is a follow-up to recent school communications, especially for our hybrid, in-person students and families, focused on daily health reminders. This follow-up stresses the importance of adhering to all health and safety protocols to keep our students and staff safe.

In an effort to remain transparent with our school community, a dashboard has been created to share the number of confirmed positive cases in our school district. The dashboard is currently accessible on the district homepage at www.eht.k12.nj.us, and will soon be present on all school webpages as well. This is certainly not meant to alarm our school community, but instead to keep everyone informed. Similar to the State of NJ Covid-19 Dashboard, the EHT School District Dashboard will keep our school community informed. Please keep in mind that if your child is considered a "close contact" you will be contacted by the school district, as well as the County Health Department as part of our contact tracing.

Additionally, as part of your Daily Health Assessment for your child, there is a question in regard to travel, within the past 14 days, to an area of high community transmission. Should your child travel to an area on [New Jersey's Travel Advisory List](#) (linked), it is the expectation of the EHT School District that your child quarantine for the required 14 days upon return to NJ. The NJ Travel advisory website states, "the self-quarantine is voluntary, but **compliance is expected.**" In partnership with the district we are expecting the same compliance in an effort to maintain in-person learning, while keeping our students and staff safe. Please also keep in mind that should your child travel to a state on the list, upon their return you should document their travel on the Daily Health Screening Form and keep your child home from school. However, during this time your child should participate in virtual learning while quarantining.
