PreK – 2nd:

Monday - Friday

- **Shirt:** Red polo/golf shirt with school logo
- **Bottoms:** Navy blue slacks, navy blue knee length shorts, or navy blue knee length jumper/skort (girls)

3rd – 5th:

Monday:

- **Shirt:** Light blue button-up oxford with school logo and navy blue tie (boys)/crisscross tie (girls) •
- Bottoms:** Navy blue slacks (no shorts or skorts)

Tuesday – Friday:

- **Shirt:** Red polo/golf shirt with school logo
- **Bottoms:** Navy blue slacks (no shorts or skorts)

6th – 8th:

Monday:

- **Shirt:** Light blue button-up oxford with school logo and navy blue tie (boys)/crisscross tie (girls) •
- Bottoms:** Navy blue slacks (no shorts or skorts)

Tuesday – Friday:

- **Shirt:** Light blue blue polo/golf shirt with school logo
- **Bottoms:** Navy blue slacks (no shorts or skorts)

***Fridays- Students are permitted to wear jeans with the purchased school spirit shirt(red or blue)**

ADDITIONAL UNIFORM DETAILS

Shirts: Shirt tails are to be tucked in and may NOT be worn outside of the pants.

Bottoms: Pants are to be navy blue-colored dress, non-denim, uniform type slacks. Pants are to be the appropriate size for the students, must fit properly at the waist, and may be **neither too tight nor too baggy**. Bell-bottom, cargo, corduroy, patch-pocketed or jean type pants are not allowed as part of the uniform. Pants are to be hemmed (shoe-top length) and have no frayed edges or cut bottoms. Uniform shorts and skorts must be knee length.

Undershirt: Only plain white undershirts may be worn underneath uniform shirts

Belts: Traditional solid black uniform belt

Socks: Solid white crew socks

Shoes: All black, closed-toe tennis shoes

Outerwear:

In cold weather, students may wear the school sweatshirt or jacket over their uniform shirt. No other outerwear may be worn when inside the building.

Accessories:

Hats, caps, hoods, bandanas, handkerchiefs, visors, hair curlers, gloves, headdress, and sunglasses (unless prescribed by a physician) may NOT be worn in the building or in class during the regular school day. Excessive jewelry or jewelry including hoop and dangling earrings may not be worn. Stud type earrings are allowed.

Note: For the 2018-19 year only, girls will be allowed to wear plaid (Plain 37) bottoms, as allowed under the previous operator. Plaid bottoms will **not be allowed in 2019-20 or beyond, and parents are not encouraged to newly purchase them.*
