INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC DEPARTMENT STUDENT FEES 2022 - 2023

HIGH SCHOOL EXPENSES

- A. Uniform Expenses
 1. \$5.00 Blazer Cleaning Fee each year for males.
 2. All Males must furnish black slacks, black dress shoes, black socks, and tuxedo shirt (one-time purchase).
 3. Females purchase a long black dress \$60-\$70 (one-time purchase).
 4. Jazz band members (male and female) must furnish a long-sleeved black button-down dress shirt, black slacks, black belt, black socks, and black shoes.
 5. Some years we use an organizational t-shirt (approximately \$15). We try to absorb this cost through donations or booster parents.

- B. Marching Band
 1. A \$75 fee each year that covers marching band uniform cleaning, gloves, drill and music.
 2. Black marching band shoes - \$35 (one-time purchase).
 3. \$100 Color Guard Fee for guard shoes and performance apparel.

- C. Band and Orchestra Method Books at \$5.95 - \$9.95 per book (one book per group).

- D. Individual Entry Fees (encouraged but not required)
 1. Honor Organization Audition Entry Fee (All-State, NCDA, NCHO, NOC, etc.) which run from \$8 - \$16 per entry.
 2. Hotel and Participation Fees (if applicable) if selected for the honor group with the cost around \$25 - \$50 per student (except for all-State, which instrumental music departmental funds pay for the student).
 3. OSSAA District and State Solo and Small Ensemble Entry Fees which range from \$5-\$12 per entry/per student depending on event they enter

- E. Out-of-State Contest Trips
 1. Trips normally planned every other year, unless something special arises.
 2. Attempt to keep costs between \$450 - \$650 per person.
 3. Have the opportunity for several fundraisers to pay for trip.

EAST AND WEST MIDDLE SCHOOL EXPENSES

Please do not bring money in for fees until requested to do so by the director. Some fees could be covered by fund raising.

- A. Uniform Expenses
 - 1. Blue concert blazer cleaning fee at East - \$5
 - 2. Must furnish black slacks/skirt, black hosiery, black dress shoes, and white tuxedo shirt.
- B. Band/Orchestra Method Books at \$9.95 - \$11.95 per book (one book per group).
- C. Individual entry Fees (encouraged but not required) – same as high school except there is no All-State group at the middle school level and there is no OSSAA State Solo and Ensemble Contest.
- D. East Band and Orchestra also requests (not required) that each student purchase a tuner and metronome which start around \$20.

5th GRADE ORCHESTRA EXPENSES

- A. Orchestra Method Book at around \$10.00
- B. Rosin for bow around \$3.50
- C. Cellos/Basses also need a rock stop and Violin/Violas some type of shoulder rest. (\$5.00 - \$15.00)

ALL DISTRICT-WIDE SCHOOL-OWNED INSTRUMENTS

There is an instrument protection plan in place at all grade levels for \$40 per year per student (or a maximum of \$70 per family). Students that play more than 1 school instrument will pay \$30 for their second instrument, paying no more than \$70 total per family. This is sort of an insurance plan that allows a parent to pay only a \$25 deductible fee for instrument repairs. Otherwise, they are to pay for all repairs made to the instrument while in the student's possession. If the damage was due to misuse or neglect then the student is to pay for entire repair regardless of the instrument protection plan. We will work with families with financial difficulties on this plan.
