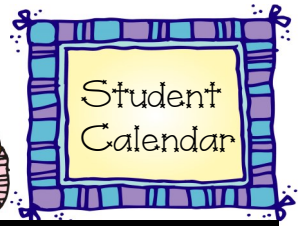

All visitors to schools, including parents, shall be required to sign-in and shall have a personal identification card (ID) scanned into the LPSD electronic visitor management system in order to receive a visitor's pass. We will not accept the digital Louisiana Wallet driver's license as a form of ID for entering a school, as it cannot be scanned in our visitor management system. The visitor's ID will be held until the pass is returned upon the visitor's departure (stipulations can only be waived for large events at the discretion of the principal); visitor passes will not be used for multiple days. The electronic visitor management system is utilized by local and state law enforcement to ensure sex offenders are not permitted on to school property.</p>
