WHAT IS ORCHESTRA CLINIC?

Orchestra clinic is an opportunity for young musicians to meet new friends through a fun and engaging experience while enhancing their musical skills and abilities in a relaxed, summer atmosphere.

WHAT WILL WE DO?

Student musicians will be in small ensembles and cover topics such as instrument fundamentals, Masterclass presentations, music reading, Mid-State preparation, chamber music, and sectionals.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Rising MNPS 6th-12th graders who have completed at least one school year of orchestra may attend. All attendees must commit to attending all four clinic days. Students will be placed in small ensembles based on their instrument, as well as their orchestra director's assessment of their skill level.

WHO IS THE CLINIC STAFF?

Instruction will be provided by experienced and dedicated MNPS instrumental music teachers.
