The Virginia Board of Education is revising its accreditation standards to provide a more comprehensive view of school quality while encouraging continuous improvement for all schools and placing increased emphasis on closing achievement gaps. School accreditation ratings for the 2018-2019 school year will be the first to reflect this new approach to accountability.

\*Superintendent of Public Instruction James Lane exercised emergency authority, on August 4, 2020, granted to him by the 2020 General Assembly to waive annual school accreditation for the 2021-2022 academic year. Schools will be assigned a rating of "Accreditation Waived," the same rating assigned schools for 2020-2021 under a waiver issued in April due to the ongoing impact of Covid-19 on public instruction.
