



Safety Audit and Updates

Our administrative team met several times over the summer with a security consultant and the Morton Grove PD and FD to go over the results and develop/revise safety procedures. Highlights include:

- All GMS students will be required to wear lanyards with their ID badges
- All Visitors will be required to go through a security check at the offices of each school and exchange their IDs for a visitor badge
- All adults will wear a lanyard with an ID (staff, substitutes, visitors)
- All classroom doors will be locked at all times and can only be opened from the outside with a key
- New door alarms installed on exterior doors- an alarm will sound when an unauthorized door has been accessed
- Our crisis plan was reviewed and revised
- Staff will have updated safety training on Institute Day



COVID Updates

The IDPH and our local health department have indicated that they are aligning themselves to the recommendations of the CDC. Here is a summary of key revisions to the guidance to continue to keep students, staff, and families safe:

- Removes the recommendation to quarantine for close contacts (individuals who have been exposed to COVID-19 should wear a well-fitted mask for 10 full days after exposure and should get tested on day 6)
- No longer recommends routine screening testing in K-12 schools (focus testing on high-risk activities during high COVID-19 Community Level or in response to an outbreak)
- Removes the recommendation for separating students into cohorts (eases social distancing guidelines, which Illinois has already been following)
- Eliminates the recommendation to Test to Stay after potential exposure

D67 Response to COVID

- Continue to employ cleaning and sanitary measures
- Continue to encourage staff and students to use good hand hygiene
- Individuals who test positive must isolate from school for 5 days from the onset of symptoms or the day of the positive test. They are encouraged to wear a mask to school for days 6-10
- Individuals who are sick should stay home
- We will offer rapid testing for students who have symptoms at school. A parent consent form was sent out via email to allow for the health staff to administer or monitor the tests.
- SHIELD testing will be available for students after school on Tuesdays from 4-5:30 pm
- We will continue to monitor community levels of transmission and will update plans as necessary or as directed by our local health departments
