



### Parental/Guardian Consent Form

In accordance with New Jersey Statute N.J.S.A. 18A:36-35, we are sending you this consent form to both inform you and to request permission for your child's photos/image/videos, classwork, and personally identifiable information to be published on the district and/or school's website, websites affiliated with the district, local news outlets, as well as on any social media accounts managed or owned by the district to highlight special events and accomplishments.

As you are aware, there are potential dangers associated with the posting of personally identifiable information since global access to the Internet does not allow us to control who may access such information. These dangers have always existed; however, we as schools do want to celebrate your child and his/her work. The law requires that we ask for your permission to use information about your child.

Pursuant to law, we will not release any personally identifiable information without prior written consent from you as parent or guardian. Personally, identifiable information includes student names, photos/images/videos, residential addresses, e-mail addresses, phone numbers, and locations and times of class trips.

If you as the parent or guardian, wish to rescind this agreement, you may do so at anytime in writing by sending a letter to the principal of your child's school and such rescission will take effect upon receipt by the school.

- I/We **DO NOT GRANT** permission for photos/images/videos and classwork that includes this student to be published.

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#### **Bill A592: Prohibits Dissemination of Personal Student Information on the Internet Without Parental Consent**

On January 8, 2002, Bill A592, as listed below, was passed by the legislature.  
*Be It Enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

*The board of education of each school district and the board of trustees of each charter school that establishes an Internet web site, shall not disclose on that web site any personally identifiable information about a student without receiving prior written consent from the student's parent or guardian on a form developed by the Department of Education. The written consent form shall contain a statement concerning the potential dangers of personally identifiable information about individual students on the Internet.*

*As used in this act, "personally identifiable information" means student names, student photos, student addresses, student e-mail addresses, student phone numbers, and locations and times of class trips.*

*This act shall take effect immediately.*
