

# Quick Reference Guide to Access Pearson/Savvas High School Integrated Math Textbooks Digitally\*

1. Log into Classlink: <https://launchpad.classlink.com/sbcusd>

**Username** = Network username

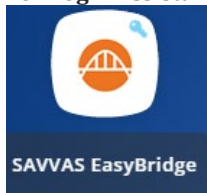
(\*\* *in most cases* FirstNameLastname)

**Password** = District Email Password (same as before)

*\*\*May differ if full name is too long or multiple users with same name*

2. Click on the icon for Savvas EasyBridge

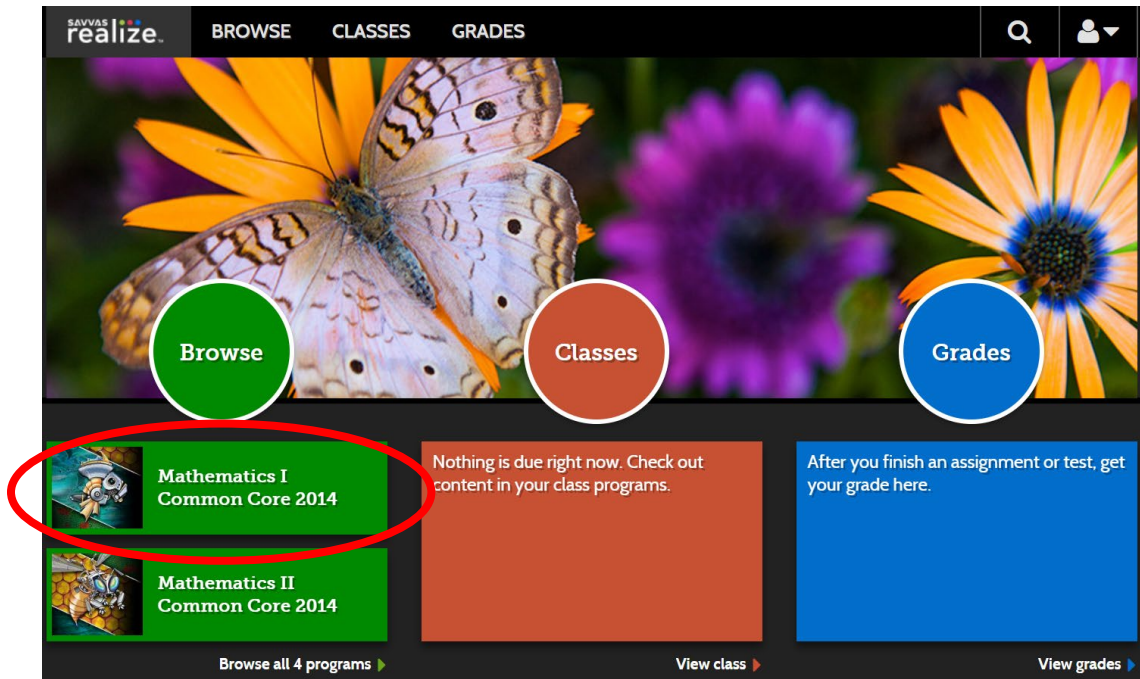
3. Click on **your textbook title or the Realize button.**



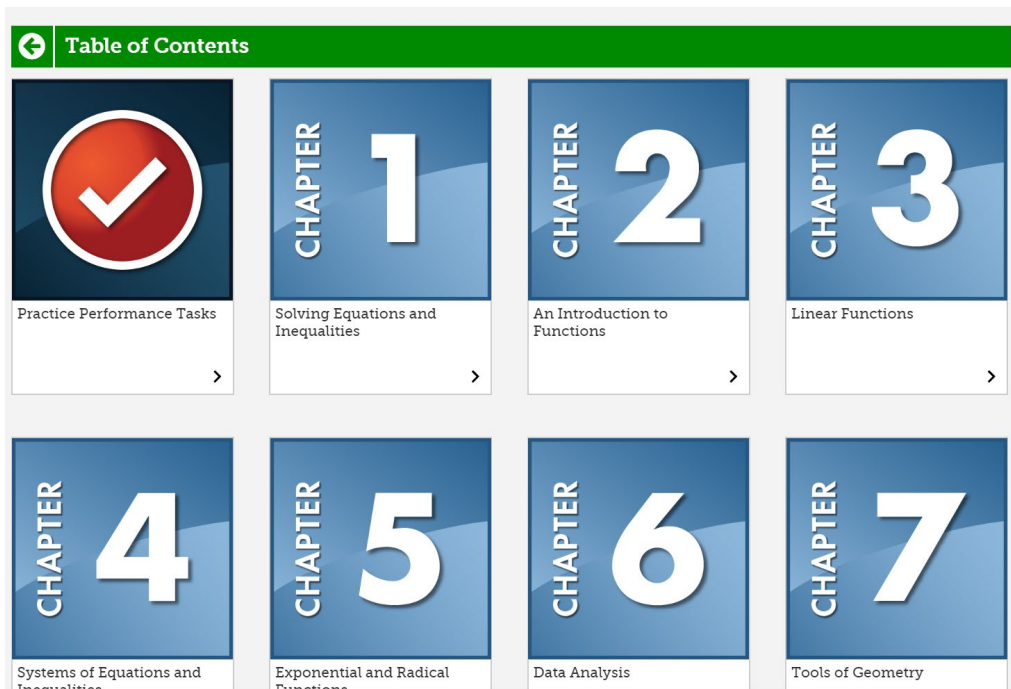
\*The first time you access Savvas Realize you will need to complete the 3-step set-up process.

1. Choose your preferred language
2. Pick a profile icon
3. Pick a background image for your homepage

4. Here you will be able to see the digital textbook(s) and assignments that your teacher has assigned to you. Click on a textbook title under **Browse** to access the digital textbook(s). (Note: *The textbooks listed below are not necessarily your textbook.*)



5. This opens a clickable **table of contents** with sample problems and the digital text by section.



6. Clicking on the **Classes** tab on the top of the screen also leads to a full student e-text and the tools shown below:
